

#### **Announcements:**

- August Forecast to MyReports: The regularly scheduled August 14<sup>th</sup> forecast to MyReports has been turned off in order to accommodate the campus year-end close and UPlan annual maintenance. The scheduled jobs will resume September 14<sup>th</sup>. The first new-year forecast will be sent in early September after the UPlan yearend/open process is complete.
- **UPlan Downtime:** UPlan will be down for the year-end/open activities beginning Monday, August 13 through Friday, August 31. These are the summary highlights of what will be completed:
  - $\circ \quad \text{June Final actuals will be loaded}$
  - Approved Plans will be copied to Final Plans
  - o UPlan data will be archived
    - The archived data will be accessible to all planners as a separate application when UPlan re-opens
  - $\circ\quad$  July 1 ChartField changes will be implemented
  - o PLUS data will be imported
  - o Years will roll over and new Forecast year will be seeded from Plan Final
    - FY19 = Year 0 Forecast
    - FY20 = Year 1 Plan
    - FY21 = Year 2 Plan
    - In CommtPln, FY29 = Year 10 Plan
  - o July FY19 actuals will be loaded
  - o UPlan will send 2018-19 August Forecast and 2018-19 Plan Final to MyReports
  - New Employee ETL will be deployed to UPlan production environment
